then present do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said John C. Green all the right all
Right or power of Land wherein the said John C. Green now lies Containing Thirteen acres
by the same more or less Situated in the District and State of South Carolina lying on the
North of Maple Swamp Creek Beginning at a Rock by running S. 84° E 14'
to a Stake by bounded by George Cunningham Land Thence S 31° E 18° 37' to a Stake,
Thence S 31° E 14° 10' to a channel bounded by said George Land Thence N 38° E 28° 40'
to a Hickory by bounded by said George Land Thence N 27° E 40° 40' to the Beginning

Together with all and singular the rights, members, franchises, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said foregoing premises belonging or in any wise incident thereto
pertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned
unto the said John C. Green his heirs and assigns forever unto I do hereby bind myself
my heirs, executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and every right
the said premises unto the said John C. Green his heirs and assigns against myself him or
my heirs or against all and every other person or persons lawfully claiming them
at any part thereof Witness my Hand and seal 30th January 1845
