West April 13th 1836 and granted unto the said John Brightmore by grant
the 23rd April 1836 having such and so much acreage as represented by a
plat attached and set out as the Land of John Brightmore released

Together with all and singular the hereditaments rights manors
appertaining whatsoever to the said Tract of Land belonging or in any wise
subsisting and the reversiones and remainders, rents, issues, and profits thereof and also all
estate right, title interest, claim, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand what-
ever in law and equity of the said and representatives of the said John Brightmore
or of all the parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully claiming a to claim
same or any part thereof by whom or under whom or either of them to have and to hold
said Tract of Land with its hereditaments franchises and appurtenances unto the said John
Brightmore his heirs and assigns to him and his only proper use and behoof forever
