in the State aforesaid have granted sold and released and by these presents do  
do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said J. H. Benedict all that land 1852  
a parcel of Land lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the  
waters of Richland creek waters of Rocky River, Beginning at a Black Gum  
running thence to an ash, thence to a Sapressa, thence to a Schmut, thence to the South  
beginning, corner, and containing Eight acres more or less, bounded by lands herein  
as follows on the east and south by Shiver & Hobut's Land on the West and North by  
lands of William Henry, William Roberts and James Hobut.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Privileges, Accoutrements, same  
and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident thereto  
To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said J. H. Benedict his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind  
myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and give defense all  
and singular the said premises unto the said J. H. Benedict his heirs and assigns  
against me and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming  
or to claim the same or any part thereof.
