To all to whom these presents shall come I William A. McLamb
of Greenville District and State aforesaid

Greeting Whereas by virtue of a Writ of Garnishee issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the District of Richland, on the sixteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty at the suit of the Plaintiff made to me directed commanding me that of the Goods and chattels movable and immovable of John Harrison to levy the sum of Two Thousand and forty seven dollars and ninety cents damages and costs I have seized and taken of the said a and tenements of the said John Harrison all that certain piece parcel and another Tract of Land containing One hundred and fifty Acres (more or less) situated same as to being in the District of Greenville on the waters of Rock Hill, being the two corners of Land wherein John Harrison now lives adjoining Lands of Miller and Dawson.

Know wherefore That I W. A. McLamb Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said Writ of Garnishee aforesaid to me directed and obtained on behalf of the said Plaintiff of the said John Harrison by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of Twenty Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to paid by the said John Drennan the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said John Drennan his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of Land with its appurtenances and the estate, right, title and interest which the said John Harrison of right had of in right and to the same To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract of Land and that with its appurtenances unto the said John Drennan his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as the said W. A. McLamb Sheriff might be entitled to grant, bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said Writ of Garnishee or otherwise.
