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Whereas the said Elijah Barnett stands fully indebted unto the said
Clayton Bramwell in the sum of One Hundred and Thirty six dollars 39 $\frac{1}{4}$ cents
which is in his honest money and in order to secure the same as well as in case
of non payment of the aforesaid debt are in the latter securing the payment thereof with
only an lawful interest. That he granted bargained sold and released and confirmed as
by sure that presents do grants, Bargain, sell and release unto the said Clayton Bramwell
of the will a certain Tract or parcel of Land Situated in said District on the bank
of an branch of the North Fork of Saluda River Containing Fifty & a half acres the
aforesaid same more or less. It being a Tract of land purchased by me of
the two James H. Tally & Wren the condition of the aforesaid obligation is such that if the
said Elijah Barnett shall pay the aforesaid sum of One hundred and thirty six
dollars 39 $\frac{1}{4}$ cents with interest from date than the obligation to be void and if the said
Elijah Barnett shall fail to pay the aforesaid sum of One hundred and thirty six dollars
