Greeting

I know by that in consideration of your integrity and skill
full power is truly given to you or any two of you to take the relinquishment of
estate and inheritance of S. Maria Lewis wife of Dr John W Lewis of
this day of April in the State of Georgia in all and singular the property described
in the foregoing deed signed by the said Dr John W Lewis and Sarah Maria
Lewis his wife. For this purpose you will cause the Sarah W Lewis to appear
before you and you will examine her privately and separately apart from
all other persons, and if upon such examination actually join her husband
executing the deed of release aforesaid that the said release was positively
and bona fide executed at least seven days before such the examination
and that she did then, at the execution of the said release and still does
at the time of examination freely voluntarily and without any manner
of compulsion dead or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, renounces
release, and forever relinquish all her estate interest and inheritance in
the property mentioned and conveyed in the said release unto Samuel
W. Cagle his heirs and assigns. Then you shall take under her hand a
certificate of her relinquishment as aforesaid in the form of a declaration
upon private examination as aforesaid which certificate authenticating
your hands and seals, you shall annex to this writ.
