South Carolina } Know all men by these present
County of District of said in consideration of

the sum of five hundred dollars to me paid
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release all that plantation or tract
and containing one hundred and twenty four acres (more or less) unto the said James
Reese being a part of the tract of land whereon William Christ De Land born
as the upper survey lot number three surveyed and laid out by Samuel Wood,
now taken according to said survey situate and lying in the state and District of eastern
part of the Branches of the Reddy fork waters of Reddy River. Beginning on or at a
Spanish Oak 3x thence S 70° E 58' to a stake 3x thence S 70° W 46' to a crop small
chestnut by a pine and Hickory stations to Black Jack 3x, bending on soil and
near Smiths Land thence N 20° W 106' to Red Oak 3x thence N 60° E 450' to stake 3x
to N 20° W 29' to stake and across a branch or creek thence N 15° E 12' to the
river corner on this line a post oak station. The above transfer is to be taken accord-
ing to the original survey made the 18th day of September 1845 then in 1847 18th Octbr
divided into three tracts the above being lot number three. Together with all and sing-
ular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances to the premises belong-
ing in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
premises above mentioned unto the said James Reese his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend the
and singular the said premises against myself my heirs and every other person whom-
soever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
