Running thence up to said Street (100 feet) one hundred feet and thence
on the 1st line to which line add one hundred and fifty feet, thence along
the last mentioned line to the Street leading from said Coffee Street to said Female
Academy, thence with said street to the beginning corner containing out of an
area of an acre more or less together with all and singular the building, improvements
