boundaries as follows in a plat of the same certified by John G. Hoyt Esq.  
from a survey made April 3<sup>rd</sup> 1850. viz. Beginning at a P.C. from the  
dwelling house and running thence S. 15 E. 8.75 to a R. C. 3<sup>rd</sup> thence S.  
E. 23.50 to a Chestnut 3<sup>rd</sup> thence S. 20 E. 24. to a Hickory 3<sup>rd</sup> thence N.  
74.92 passing the P.C. to a Stake on road, thence S. 39 E. 82 to a Rock  
& thence S. 59 E. 32 to a P.C. 3<sup>rd</sup> thence S. 34 W. 36 to a W.C. 3<sup>rd</sup> on road thence N.  
with said road to the beginning corner bounded by Lands of Almon, End  
Bessellor, George Roberts and others.

containing and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging aforesaid  
more incident appertaining.

the same or any part thereof.
