said H. B. Brooks his executors and assigns forever.

Provided always and it is the true intent and meaning  
of the parties to these presents that of the said Genl G. Green his executors admis-  
trators, or assigns shall well and truly pay a cause to the sum into the  
hands of H. B. Brooks his executors administrators or assigns the sum  
of one thousand dollars with interest annually as shown by the note aforesaid  
in accordance with the true intent and meaning of the said Deed and  
hereinafter these presents shall be held void of any thing herein contained  
to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding

And it is covenanted and agreed upon between the parties to  
these presents that until default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid  
sum as before herein set forth it shall and may be lawful to and for the said  
Genl G. Green peaceably and quietly to hold, possess, occupy and enjoy  
the place where all and singular the premises above granted and where ever any part  
thereof with the appurtenances and to take the rents, profits thereof to his own  
use and behoof any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding
