The 1 <sup>st</sup> Track containing One Hundred acres which I purchased from Marshall Hawkins, Beginning on an iron post at a point corner joining D. P. Phillips et al. Thence along Phillips line to a Red Oak, thence to a pine, thence to a post oak, thence to a Spanish Oak, thence to a point on Marsh- alls line thence to a corner on Jem Phillips corner, thence a straight line to a public road, South at the Meeting House, thence still passing Phillips line, to a post oak, thence along the same to a post oak thence along W. Watson line to a post oak, thence to a pine, thence along J. May line to the beginning.
