South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I Samuel M. Earle of Greenville in the State of South Carolina do grant, bargain and release unto the said Waddy Thompson all that tract of land containing 245 acres beginning at a bridge over the ditch on the South side of a stream which runs to a state Thence N 45° 35' E to a stake at the top of a bank of a prairie Thence N 73° 19' to Black Gum at the head of a branch Thence down the branch to a stake on the river Thence down the meanders of the river to the mouth of a creek Thence up the creek to the beginning and also one other branch beginning at a black gum corner at the head of a branch Thence South 73° 19' to a stake corner Thence N 24° E 45.30 to a stake corner Thence N 15° E 27.75 to another stake Thence N 49° 44' 30" S 50° 50" to Rock Oak double corner Thence S 20° 44' E to a point stake on Rocky River Thence down the meanders of the River to a stake corner opposite the mouth of a branch Thence up said branch to the beginning containing for the sum of one hundred and two acres

To have and to hold all and singular the Rights, Privileges, Benefits, easements and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby give myself my true Execution and Administration to warrant and give defense to all and singular the said Premises unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully bring or to claim the same or any part thereof.
