Together with all and singular the Rights, members, Inventions and Appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining thereto. And I the said Jacob S. Rhodes do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators and assigns forever to warrant and defend the above granted premises against myself my heirs and assigns and against any and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

This Deed to take effect after the death of myself and my wife until which time we and my wife are to occupy and retain all the Rights of possession and all the privileges of proprietorship that we have ever and will be enjoyed.
