Witness all men by these presents That I John W Watson of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina Deed to me paid by John F Carpenter of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said John F Carpenter all that piece of land lying and being in the Incorporated limits of the village of Greenville on the North West side of the Pendleton Road about  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a mile from the Court House in being described as follows I now reside Beginning on a Stake at corner of Septima Street Lot and line Thence up the Pendleton road South 65° N 308 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to a Stake of Thence N 22° W 378 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to a Stake at Thence N 48° E 308 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to a Stake at said corner back line Thence with Watson's line S 22° E 378 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to the beginning being the lot Varday Mcbee conveyed to me containing one acre, one Reed & 13 perches.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Appendages and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John F Carpenter his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John F Carpenter in his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs or any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
