two or more of you To take the renunciation of Eliza Earle wife of S. McEarle former  
Cherokee County in the State of Georgia of the Power in the premises described to have  
in the said Cherokee annex'd a sum of £1000 to Waddy Thompson dated at the  
3<sup>r</sup> September 18<sup>th</sup> Conveying a Tract of Land Situate in Greenville District  
South Carolina as in particular, as reference to the Deed will more fully appear this 2<sup>d</sup>

For this purpose you will cause the said Eliza Earle to appear before  
you and you will examine her privately and separately apart from all persons  
and upon such examination she shall freely declare that she does freely volunt  
arily and without any compulsion clear of fear of any person whatsoever makes  
release and forever relinquish to Waddy Thompson the sum and ays in all her  
interest and estate and also all the right and claim of Power of in and to all the  
singular the premises described and conveyed in the Deed aforesaid

Then you shall take under<sup>th</sup> hand a certificate of the renunciation  
as aforesaid in the form of a declaration upon private examination as aforesaid which  
certificate authenticated by your hands and seals you shall annex to this Deed and  
having certified and signed by your hands and seals the due execution of this writing and witness  
the same by the oath of one of you before some Magistrate who is authorised by the Laws  
of your State to administer an oath and whose official signature may be properly  
authenticated you shall cause to return this writing together with your proceeding thereon  
to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions for Greenville District in the  
State of South Carolina to be duly recorded

soever renounce, release, and forever relinquish unto Waddy Thompson of Greenville  
District State of South Carolina his heirs and assigns all my interest and estate  
also all my right and claim of Power of in and to all and singular the premises  
conveyed and described in a Deed from the said Samuel McEarle to the said Waddy  
Thompson, dated the third day of September One thousand eight hundred and  
fifty six conveying a tract of Land containing Six Thousand and forty seven  
Acres more or less Situate in Greenville District on the Waters of Reedy River  
in Consideration of Six Thousand Dollars paid by the said Waddy Thompson  
to the said Samuel McEarle
