unto the said Abram Williamson his heirs and assigns forever And I, Jack S.  
do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend  
against all the purchasers before mentioned unto the said Abram Williamson  
and his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming unto claim the same or any part thereof.

of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three.
