Together with all and singular the rights, members, interest, & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said premises aforesaid unto the said Hough Stokes his heirs, executors, administrators & assigns forever And I do hereby declare myself my executors, Administrators & assigns to warrant and defend all and singular the aforesaid premises unto the said Hough Stokes against myself and every other person or persons whomsoever & lawfully claiming a to claim the same or any part thereof.
