The State afuersaid in consideration of Five Hundred and Sixty Dollars to me paid by Charles Pinckney Hill of Greenville District in the State afuersaid Slave granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargained sold and release unto the said Charles Pinckney Hill that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing one hundred acres and one fourth acres, more or less, lying and situate in the District and State aforesaid upon the East Side of Saluda River adjoyning belonging to William Hunt aforesaid Abram Granger and Samuel McLean bounded as follows Beginning at a rock on Grangers corner on the White Horse road and running thence S 44° W 21 chs to a Rock, N 44° W 28 chs 33 chs to a Hogback on the North side of a branch thence N 44° E 35 chs to a Red Oak at the road thence with a bend eastward N 45° E 34 chs to a Rock at the White Horse Road thence along said Road S 42° E ch. 36 chs to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Privileges and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging unto any and whosoever in possession or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Charles Pinckney Hill his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby disclaim myself of my heirs Executors and Administrators warrant and general defense all and singular the said premises unto the said Charles Pinckney Hill his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming to claime the same or any part thereof.
