Whereas Israel Charles and Joel Charles did on or about the thirtieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two exhibit their Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Granville Court House in the said State against Elias Garrison and Mary Garrison his wife and others who are whereby they pray for (among other matters) a division of the Real Estate which John Charles late deceased did seize and possess

And the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court of Equity at Chambers on the second day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two when the said Court after full hearing and mature deliberation in the premises did Order Adjudge and decree that the said lands should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the said Court in the Terms and for the purposes mentioned in their Decretal Order as by reference thereunto in the Registry of the said Court will appear And the said Samuel A. James Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said lands for sale by Public outcry on the sixth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two did then openly and Publicly and according to the custom of Auction sell and dispose of the said land hereon described unto the said Israel Charles for the sum of Five Thousand one hundred and sixty dollars the being at that price the highest bidder for the same

And therefore This Indenture Witnesseth That the said Samuel A. James as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand one hundred and sixty dollars paid him by the said Israel Charles the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged with Charter, Bargain, Sale and Release and by their joint and doth Grant Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Israel Charles his heirs and assigns all that Tract or parcel of Land lying and being situate in the State and District aforesaid which was resumed by John Charles late deceased on the 1st Oct. 1833 and a plan of the same made by the said Israel Charles is described as follows Tract No. 3.
