Now it is hereby declared by and between the parties and the said  
said Caroline S. Hedges in behalf and the Executrix Administratrix and agrees  
with covenant, promise and agree to and with the said Massena Taylor and  
the Executrix Administratrix and agrees by these presents that if default shall happen to appear  
on the part of the said John Hedges in payment of the sum above mentioned according to the above  
time intent and meaning of the said note under seal that then and in such case before payment  
it shall and may be lawful to and upon the said Massena Taylor the Executrix Administratrix  
- Administratrix, Assignee, Attorney or Agents from time to time and at any times hereinafter  
- after peaceably and quietly to enter into any or all the messuages, lands or tenements by the said  
the said Caroline S. Hedges and to take the said negro and the said interest in  
the estate of said John Hedges into his custody and possession and the same to  
detain to his own use and behoof as his own proper goods and chattels  
from thenceforth and forever as the same to sell and dispose of at his sole and pleasure  
returning the surplus of any sum so happen to be after paying of the sum above  
mentioned unto the said Caroline S. Hedges the Executrix Administratrix aforesaid.

the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America
