dollars to me in hand paid by Centis Bryant of the same State and District of Spartanburg,
have granted sold and released and by these presents do sell and release unto the said
Centis Bryant a certain Tract or parcel of Land Containing Eighty acres, in the
same more or less Situated and lying in the District of Greenville on the waters
of South Pacolet, North side of S. River Beginning on a Stake a condition being
line between Sock Lindsey and Charles Garnett Stone, to a Chestnut Stake to a
Spanish Oak Stone to a Holly white oak Stake to an old Chestnut Stone to a
old original as the marks sun Stake to a Stake Stone North by degrees east
a Stake Stone to the beginning. The being a part of the old Simpson's Tract of
Land lying on the Glazier Mountain.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, time
dutments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise made
or appertaining.

I do have and to hold all and singular the premises before named
unto the said Centis Bryant his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind
myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and defend the
same singular the said premises unto the said Centis Bryant his heirs and assigns
against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming
to claim the same or any part thereof.
