 granted to John Meads containing Five hundred and thirty six acres more or less
 beginning on a small chunk of Meads old corner running South by N 1/2
 W 1/2 to the Marsh Creek supposed to be 8 chains 30 links Thence up the
 creek to the State road thence along the road on Mansua Taylor line to a
 stake Thence East by to the beginning on Purvis line

Together with all and singular the rights liberties
 and appurtenances in the said premises belonging or in any
 way incident or appertaining It have and do hold all and singular
 the premises here mentioned with the said James M Taylor his heirs and
 assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Adm
 orators to warrant and defend all and singular the said prem
 is with the said James M Taylor his heirs and assigns against me and
 my heirs and all other lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof
