Whereas by these presents that Elizabeth Rice of the District and State aforesaid  
consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear to my daughter  
Elizabeth Cockram wife of John Cockram having given transfer and delivered to me  
and by these presents do give transfer and deliver to Elizabeth Cockram of  
Charleston District the following personal property To wit one negro girl named Anna  
about 18 years old together with the furniture inclosed

To have and to hold the said property unto the said Elizabeth  
Cockram as Trustee for executors and Administrators of the said Estate  
themselves and to and for the following uses and purposes that is to say in trust for the  
sole and separate use of the said Elizabeth Cockram my daughter during  
her natural life, the life time intend in the same to her in no wise responsible for  
debts or contracts, in the payment of funeral debts of the Husband Mrs in the country  
the said negro becoming an expense they the said negro to be paid out of  
their support and after the same are all necessary expenses are paid thereon  
due of any sum owing by the before mentioned Trustee to the said Elizabeth Cockram  
annually during her natural life time and therfrom are to be immediately applied  
to death & the use of her expenses, the use of a deceased child to take the place she  
will the cost of her children.
