
C W Coleman	Deed	No.	State of South Carolina
to Mavencroft (Keween)	in Land	May 15	Greenville District

I do remember that C W Coleman did purchase from Booker Bonsor a tract of land lying and being in Greenville District wherein I do not know the name being a part of the tract of land wherein Thomas Benson did live at the time of his death and was sold by Silas Benson the Executor of the aforesaid Thomas Benson in conformity with the directions given me by the will of Thomas Benson made a survey of the lands belonging to the estate of Samuel Mavencroft deceased made by Thomas Gairin a Deputy Surveyor it does appear that the survey made by said Gairin takes from the land so purchased by me from Booker Bonsor and leaving the land which was sold by the said Silas Benson Executor of Thomas Benson about fifteen acres more or less

From which I know and remember that C W Coleman have the day received from E B Benson and John P Benson the sum of One Hundred Dollars in full consideration for the said fifteen acres more or less as above stated which has been taken from me by the State of Saml Mavencroft under the aforesaid Survey made by Thomas Gairin and do hereby relinquish and release the said land unto them at Law of Saml Mavencroft and also release and discharge all claims or demands which can or may be hereafter set up against the heirs of Thomas Benson deceased or against any other person who may have purchased the said land from E B Benson and further I the said C W Coleman do hereby surrender and give up to the heirs of Saml Mavencroft full possession of the aforesaid land being due by me in consideration of the sum of One Hundred dollars as aforesaid paid to me by E B Benson and John P Benson and further the land stated above and described is more fully described by a plan hereto annexed made by Thomas Gairin
