Cleveland all that tract or plantation of land situated lying and being in the said District in the Cherokee or North Fork of Saluda River bearing the following lines courses and distances that is to say beginning at a stake 37 on the South and South West corner of Cherokee adjoining lands of James Finley Thence N 86 W 15 ch to a black gum 34 Thence N 2 W 9.90 to a white oak 34 Thence N 30 W 7.75 to a post oak 34 on Thence S 37 W 38 ch to a stake 37 and frontier Thence N 34 W 34.50 to a rock and frontier Thence S 20 W 33.30 to a pine knot 37 and frontier Thence S 66 W 7.50 to a Spanish oak 37 Thence W 22 40 to a white oak 37 on at or near the head of a branch of the Little Pigeon River Thence down the said branch with the meanders thereof to the said James H. Cleveland creek and thence from their junction down the said creek with the meanders thereof to white oak 37 on on the East bank thereof Thence East 25.4 on a stake and frontier 37 on the road from Mr Keys bridge to Pumphrey bridge Thence along said road towards the bridge to the junction a stake of the said road in a post oak 37 on on the east side of Little road at the fork, thence N 36 E 5.55 to a stone stake 37 and frontier Thence S 65 25.50 to a black gum 37 on (divided) on the Summit Road near Mr Keys bridge Thence along the road
