Garrison and Mary Garrison his wife and other wherin and whereby they may find among other matters a division of the Real Estate received by late John Charles Riccaise & his wife and purposed after the cause being fully before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at Williamston the second day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation by virtue of the Order of Service and decree that the said Lands situated in the Publice Auction of the Commissioners of the said Court on the terms and purposing mentioned in their several Orders as by reference thereto in the regular course of the said Court will appear first the said Samuel H. Morris in whom the said lands of the said Morris after having duly advertised the said lands for auction by Publice Notice on the sixth day of December in the year of one thousand eight hundred and fifty two and then openly and publicly according to the custom of Auctions sold and disposed of the said lands together with the said Soil Charles for the sum of Thirteen Pounds and Sixty five pence the being all that price the high bid bidder for the same.

Wherefore this Interlocutory Writ before the said Court is made to the said Samuel H. Morris as Commissioner of the said Court in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and sixty five Dollars paid by the said Soil Charles the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that he granted Bargain and Release to the Plaintiff and of these Presents doth Grant Bargain Sale and Release unto the said Soil Charles the same and to assign all that tract of Land lying and being situate in the State and District aforesaid known as Shublin in the State of the same and a survey thereof made by John C. and myself 1st October 1832 This tract with Beginning on the road to Greenville at Long Branch Lake of Thomas Moore Esq^r & R. C. gone, Pontoon Bridge 44^{ft} long and 14^{ft} broad, gone, Stone Smith 44^{ft} 11ⁱⁿ 34^{ft} 36ⁱⁿ long w^t 2^{ft} gone, Stone Branch to that Stake Stone Grove Creek to Stake Stone 345^{ft} E 16^{ft} 30^{ft} to the beginning containing in all Two hundred and fifty seven acres more or less.

To this with all and singular the above named Rights Mmbers stand to appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of Land belonging even anyone pertaining to the Moravians and Remained Rents Issues and Profits and also all the estate, Right Title Interest, Power Possession, Property and benefit claim and demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the Heirs and Representatives of the said John Charles Riccaise and of all the parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully claiming to claim the same or any part thereof from or under them or either of them.

To Maria and to hold the said Land with its appendants and privileges and appurtenances unto the said Soil Charles the same and of his heirs and his wife and benefit unto them forever.
