Sullivan the following personal property to West big River: Simey a black woman 35 years of age and two other children David age 13 years, Eliza an aged 8 years, Emilia aged 6 years and Bob Hotel aged 3 years, Celyah a black man 24 years of age, Dave a black man 33 years of age and Marilla a black girl 15 years of age and two kids, three hawks and their offspring, one horse and mule, two cows and calves and a two horse wagon.
