and personal estate including the manor of the said slaves during
his natural life Reserving however to the Trustee the title thence held
and prove of supervision and control to the executors however in this presentment
of the same may be necessary for the protection of said property and the benefit of the
same it may also give power and authority to sell or exchange all
part of the same part of said property and its increase by and with the consent of
my said son Garrison in the discretion of said Trustee it shall be devised
in the best and the benefit of my said son and to diminish the proceeds of such sales to
\$52,400.00 the property that will better suit my said son The property so partitioned
as may be necessary in exchange to the Trustee subject to the same provisoes
of time and exchange and upon the same Trust uses and limitations as the original
property is subjected to by the provisions of this Deed and after the death of
my said son the said property both real and personal to be so continued in Trust
and the possession use and enjoyment of such child a child as he may
have surviving him including the child a child of my deceased
son the child who will take the place of the deceased parent would be entitled to
at least one third share of my said son die without leaving any child
or children grand child or grand children in that event the said property
to be continued both real and personal and its manor is likewise so to be continued
the beginning of Trust upon possession use and enjoyment of this brother Henshaw shall
be partitioned between Moore and his sister Mary Lane Moore to be partitioned equally be
a posthumous brother or between the survivor and the child a child of the
said survivor between brother or sister as the case may be the child a child of such deceased
leaving the share of the deceased parent though should my said son leave
off alone child a child grand child or grand child of deceased brother or
sister and a surviving brother or sister than the said property both real and per
