




Margaret Wright Deed

To Samuel Styles	Date 1853	Known all meny these presents that we William Wright and Margaret Wright of the State of South Carolina and Spartanburg District of said State do make and give unto the said Samuel Styles all our interest, title, and claim, in and upon a certain parcel of land containing Two Hundred and Twenty acres more or less situated in Greenville District bounded by lands belonging to John S. Williams, Nancy Edwards and Wiley Clegg and represented by a line of Surveyor's boundaries of the same tract of land originally David W. Moore and William P. Clegg to the said Samuel Styles.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or pertaining thereto.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises above named and mentioned unto the said Samuel Styles his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs and assigns to warrant as & forever hold and defend the said premises unto the said Samuel Styles against ourselves our heirs and assigns. The Testimony whereof we have caused to be made at the tenth day of October A.D. One thousand eight hundred and fifty three.

Castlebury and made in Justice (Spartanburg District) oaths that he saw William Wright and Margaret Wright his wife of the witness named William Wright did this day appear before me and upon being fully and separately examined by me did declare that she at least seven days before such examination (was) on the tenth day of October 1853 actually joins her husband William Wright presenting the within release and that the release was fully and completely upon and along the abel least seven days before such examination and did then and at the sign and time of this examination still does fully voluntarily and without any manner of compulsion or fear of any person aforesaid whomsoever receive release and present relinquish unto the witness named Samuel Styles his heirs and assigns all his estate interest and inheritance in and to the premises mentioned in the within release Given under my hand and seal 18th day of October A.D. 1853  L. Sanford Magr.
