League have bargained sold and released and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and release a certain lot of Corn containing 25 acres more or less to include the Mill etc. & near to my house unto G. D. League his heirs and assigns forever beginning at a Holly Bush 34 and running N 3/4 E 2/4 to the corner of the lot 1/4 to a rock 34 x 8 N 66 W 9, 15 to a stake 34 x 1 A. S. W. 6, 38 to a spring in the corner of S. D. C. 7, 10 to a Willow 34 near a track 1 S 2 1/2 W 1/2 of Mill pond 34 x 1 Poplar 34 thence to the beginning corner

To give the with all and singular the right, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging

To have and to hold in peaceable possession all and singular of the above described piece of Land unto the said George D. League his heirs and assigns forever with the privilege to the old water marks when the mills were in full operation

I the said George J. Hughes do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the said tract of Land of 25 acres to the said George D. League with all the profits thereunto belonging unto the said G. D. League his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns

To have and to hold in peaceable possession against any person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof
