






In will, Molestation, Eviction or Interruption of me the said Mary Pointsett

 cutions, charges, and incumbrances whatsoever, had, made, done, committed,
 or suffered by me the said Mary Pointsett. And lastly that I the said Mary
 Pointsett, my executor and administrators and my heirs and all and every
 person or persons lawfully claiming, or to claim any estate, right, title, trust
 or interest of in, or to the said tract of land, and all and singular, thereto, in
 issue herein before mentioned and intended, to be held, granted, and released, or any
 part or parcel thereof shall and will, from and at all times hereafter, at the
 reasonable request and proper costs and charges, in the law, of the said
 A W Black, his executor or administrators, heirs and assigns, make and
 acknowledge and execute or cause to be executed and procure to be made
 done acknowledge and executed, all and every such further, and other lawful
 and reasonable acts and deeds, things and things, conveyances and assurances
 the law, whatsoever, for the further, better and more perfect and absolute
 granting, conveying, and assuring the said tract of land, and all and sin-
 gular, other the premises herein before mentioned and intended to be held,
 granted and released, and every part and parcel, with their and every of
 their appurtenances, to and for the use and behoof of the said A W Black,
 his executor, administrators, heirs and assigns forever, as by him or them
 or by his or their counsel, learned in the law, shall be reasonable desired or
