John M Roberts and I do all to whom these presents shall come  
greeting. I, Daniel Sheriff of Greenville District  
and State of mesaid, send Greeting Whereas I, virtue of a writ of Giri Facias  
and out of the court of common pleas, held for the District of Greenville  
the eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand  
one hundred and forty three at the suit of Jeremiah Cleveland a citizen  
of the said District, to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels  
lands and tenements of the said Jeremiah Cleveland to me the sum of one  
hundred and forty four dollars & 75c damages and costs I have agreed and  
paid of the lands and tenement of the said Jeremiah Cleveland all that certain  
parcel of land containing four hundred and thirty three acres  
more or less, situate and being in the District of Greenville in the state aforesaid.  
Branches of Matthews Creek and Branches of the Middle fork of Saluda  
River is bounded as follows, to wit Beginning at a locust tree by the  
rod thence S 70 E 36 5d to a red oak thence S 36 E 33 5d to a Spanish  
Oak & on thence S 70 E 60 to a stake, thence N 42 W 60 to a stake, thence  
N 20 W 91 to a stake, due west 26 30 to a hickory thence N 30 W 26 to a pillar  
thence N 69 E 33 to the Beginning containing in the whole four hundred  
and thirty three acres more or less as above stated. Now whereas the  
said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made, by virtue  
of the said writ of Giri Facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public  
sale and purchased by John M Roberto of the district aforesaid for the sum of  
two hundred and six dollars being the highest sum that was offered thereon  
you know ye, that I James M. Daniel Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said  
writ of Giri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid  
and by virtue of the statute in such case made and provided, and for and in  
consideration of the said sum of two hundred and six dollars to me in hand  
laid or secured to be paid by the said John M Roberto the receipt and pay  
ment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold and  
do grants do grant bargain sell unto the said John M Roberto, his  
heirs and assigns forever, the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appur  
tenances and all the estate, right, title and interest which the said James M. Daniel  
right had of in and to the same, to have and to hold the said piece, par  
cel tract of land with its appurtenances, unto the said John M. Roberto  
his heirs and assigns forever, as full and as absolute as I the said James M. Daniel  
right could or ought to grant & bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute  
aforesaid, and the said writ of Giri Facias or otherwise, for motives whereof I the  
said James M. Daniel Sheriff have hereunto set my hand and seal the fourth day of October  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven
