State aforesaid for and in consideration of three hundred and seventy dollars to me in hand by William A. Cauble of the District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released unto the said A. Cauble all that tract or parcel of land situated in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on waters of Enoo river, containing one hundred and eight acres more or less, it being a part of the tract one granted to Youlton Ayres the other part supposed to be granted to Robert Goodell it was purchased by John Trutin and conveyed to Joseph Coleman, and from said Coleman to Zion Taylor and from Zion Taylor to Thomas Taylor and hath such bounds and marks as followeth, beginning on a Hickory corner thence N 45° E 115 ft to a post oak corner, thence S 55° E 1290 to white oak, thence down the meander of a branch to a white oak thence N 10° E 410 ft to a S. S. Thence N 55° E 14,40 ft to a poplar stump, thence N 19° W 675 ft to a stump, thence N 56 W 1,10 ft thence S 45° W 125 ft to a water oak thence down the meander of the branch to a maple at fork of the branch thence up the left hand fork to a poplar, thence S 45° E 240 ft to the beginning corner together with all and singular the rights minerals hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said W. A. Cauble his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W. A. Cauble his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs and against every other person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
