


State of South Carolina in consideration of nine hundred fifty four dollars fifty

paid for said Bargain sold and discharged unto the said persons to the  
great Bargain sold and discharged unto the said Thomas M. Coop all the  
pieces, parts and tract of Land situated lying and being in Greenville  
District on Saluda river, containing one hundred and twenty-one and  
one half acres to the same more or less beginning on a Dogwood tree  
named Oak on the bank of Saluda river, Thence E 52 deg 50' thence a  
small Hickory 3 x 4 m. Thence S 25 1/4 E. 40' thence S 54 E. to Rock 3 x 4 m.  
S 13 3/4 W 28 thence S 22 1/2 E. to Rock 3 x 4 m. Thence W 85 W 5 1/2 E. 40' to Hickory  
3 x 4 m. Then S 61 1/4 W 1. 75 Then W 0. 34 m. to Saluda river Then  
with the various meanders of the river to the beginning corner adjoining lands  
of the said Thomas M. Coop, to him given and the said William Stunt  
together with all and singular the rights members  
and tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or  
in any wise incident or pertaining:

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Thomas M. Coop his heirs and assigns forever against me  
and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully  
claiming out to claim the same or any part thereof.
