

Lewis Sudduth	Deed for Land	667 No Acres 140	South Carolina & Greenville District Showall near the Creek called of Saluda since paid to same being part of the said Land conveyed by Thos. L. Bowley 16 <sup>th</sup> of December 1841 and returning by said Bowley to Lewis Sudduth on the 2 <sup>d</sup> of April 1845 bound as follows viz

I therefore presents that I Lewis Sudduth of the District and State aforesaid  
you and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars to me in  
hand paid by Reuben Sudduth of said District and State having granted him  
a joint sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
unto the said Reuben Sudduth a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the District  
of Anderson and Pickens or a branch of Creek called of Saluda since  
paid to same being part of the said Land conveyed by Thos. L. Bowley 16<sup>th</sup> of December 1841  
and returning by said Bowley to Lewis Sudduth on the 2<sup>d</sup> of April 1845 bound  
as follows viz  
Beginning on a Pine corner and running N 80 E. to a Point near the House  
to be kept up by R. S. of this District and State aforesaid and  
Lewis Sudduth. Then in a straight line to a rock in the Head of the  
Pine Creek Land belonging to W. Ellis aforesaid N 80 E. bearing S 66  
E 11.10 to a Stake there 3 1/2 rods west chains to a red oak standing near George  
Sherriffs Spring. Then S 33 E. W 53.40 to the beginning of the corner run-  
ning one hundred and forty four more rods.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident thereto  
having to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said Reuben Sudduth his heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my executors and administrators to warrant  
and defend all and singular the said premises unto said Reuben Sudduth  
his heirs and assigns, against myself and against any person whomsoever less  
fully claiming or to claim the same any part thereof.
