 Greenville District I go that in that year 1833 I brought to a
 Negro girl of my Father David Banton by the name of Sally and by
 command of my wife Sally Banton I gave her to my daughter Eliza
 Banton some time after my Master Banton to dispose that
 if I would give Rebecca Banton my second daughter a certain negro
 girl that's he had in his possession belonging to me by inheritance
 by command of Master that he would give her infidem & take
 her I would do so and she complied with her promise and by the
 consent of my wife Sally Banton I gave Rebecca that girl.

The above Testify I do at this statement of these two negroes
 given to my two daughters to this best of my recollection.
