of the Richard Ward Grant and running a conditional line eozing the
River about half way between the plantation of Morris Gorrell, field on
the River and continuing a straight line to the North side of the Bradel
Land Thence N 45 E 5 ch 50 to a Hickory a corner of the Butler Land Thence S 45 E 45 ch
62 with the Butler line until it strikes the line Granted to Sometime Ward of the
