Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto
the said James McMakin a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in State
and District aforesaid on the Branch waters of the Packhole River adjoining
lands of A Balow, Jonathan Ward and others Beginning at a Stake on
I Ward line and running N $^{\circ}$ 53 $'$ 4 W 33 ch 70 to a S. O. Thence with the branch
down to a maple Thence S 43 $'$ 4 W 33 ch 40 to a chestnut oak Thence on
Jonathan Ward line N $^{\circ}$ 44 W 33 ch 10 a chestnut on a large rocky cliff Thence
with the Early Lignard Grant N 25 E 22 ch 25 to a pine on Waly Balow
line Thence with said line S 45 E 5 ch to a chestnut Thence with said Balow to
N 1 E 10 ch to a maple Thence S 53 E 63 ch 50 to a Hickory Thence S 30 $'$ 7 ch 25
to a chestnut Thence S 28 E 14 ch 25 to Beginning Containing One hundred
and Sixty Two acres more or less

To have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid mentioned
 premises unto the said James McMakin his heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrato-
rators to warrant and defend all and singular the aforesaid mentioned
premises unto the said James McMakin his heirs and assigns against myself
my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
or to claim the same - any part thereof.
