This Indenture made the Thirtieth day of January in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Fifty Seven between Ebenezer W. Gowan, Thomas W. Cox, Henry C. Mackay being the firm of Gowan, Cox & Mackay Carriage Manufacturers of Greenville in the State aforesaid of the one part and Alfred Hollington of Charleston in the State aforesaid of the other part in witness whereof the said Alfred Hollington hath bargained and sold to the said Ebenezer W. Gowan, Thomas W. Cox, Henry C. Mackay, the certain Tracts of Land hereinabove described at and for the sum and price of One Thousand Dollars and whereas the said Ebenezer W. Gowan, Thomas W. Cox, and Henry C. Mackay have paid down to the said Alfred Hollington Two thousand and five hundred Dollars of the sum aforesaid and for securing the payment of the remainder, have made and executed to the said Alfred Hollington three joint and several Bonds each for the sum of Three Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars all bearing date the first day of January One thousand eight hundred and fifty seven, and respectively conditioned for payment as follows viz. one for the payment of Eighteen hundred and Sixty five Dollars on the first day of January One thousand eight hundred and fifty six, to y<sup>e</sup> other with legal interest thereon from date which is to be paid annually and quarterly One for the payment of Eighteen hundred and Seventy five Dollars on the first day of January One thousand
