Know all men by these presents, Whereas Philip Ridgeman late of Charleston in the State aforesaid Doctor of Medicine was in his life time and at the time of his death seized and possessed of a considerable Real and Personal Estate including the premises hereinafter particularly described and being so seized and possessed having in his life time to wit on the twentieth day of March in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three made and duly executed his last will and testament, wherein amongst other things he devised the rest and residue of his estate of every kind and nature unto his nephew Alfred W. Mayton and on the thirtieth day of March in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty, having made and executed a codicil to his said Will and afterwards departed this life on the eleventh day of June One thousand eight hundred and fifty leaving his said will and codicil in full force and unexecuted and whereas under and by virtue of the said will and codicil the said Alfred W. Mayton became and was the legal owner in fee simple of a certain Farm at Track of Game, situate in Greenville District and partly within the corporate limits of the Town of Greenville the same having been a portion of the said tract and residue of the Estate of the said Philip Ridgeman and being the legal rights of the said Alfred W. Mayton to the said Farm or Track of Land are recognized and decreed by the Court of Equity sitting for Charleston District at June Term One thousand eight hundred and fifty one and afterwards affirmed by the Court of Appeals on the twenty eighth day of January One thousand eight hundred and fifty two and whereas the said Alfred W. Mayton did convey to the Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company a portion to said Alfred and five one hundredths (.05) Acres of the said Farm or tract of Land in pursuance of an agreement made to and with them by the said Philip Ridgeman in his life time and in conformity with the terms of the said agreement and a record to file to Ebenezer M. Gove, Thomas C. Gove, Thomas W. Gray & Stanley being the firm of Gowers, Gray & Stanley all the remainder of the said Farm or tract of Land above for the sum of One Thousand Dollars.

I now affirm that the said Alfred W. Mayton of the City of Charleston in the State aforesaid, in pursuance of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, was affixed to said in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to be paid by the said Ebenezer M. Gove, Thomas C. Gove, Thomas W. Gray & Stanley being the firm of Gowers, Gray & Stanley
