in Greenville District of our in consideration of the sum of Five dollars besides my
natural love and affection for my son Henry D Elley to me in trust paid
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by W B Elley Trustee
for the said Henry D Elley who is a minor and to act as such till he
arrives at the age of twenty one of the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver
to the said W B Elley in Trust for the said Henry D Elley till he arrives
at the age of twenty one and then to him the said Henry D Elley discharged
of the said Trust the following slaves Thomas (son of Phibby), Matilda
daughter of Betty also, blanket a

To have and to hold the said three negroes slaves
above mentioned and their increase unto the said W B Elley Trustee for Henry
D Elley till he arrives at the age of twenty one and then to the said Henry
D Elley free of such Trust his Executors, Administrators and assigns
to him and his only proper use and benefit forever. And I the said Sarah
Elley my Executors, Administrators the said Bargained premises unto
the said W B Elley in Trust for Henry D Elley discharged of said Trust his
Executors and Administrators and assigns from and against all persons shall
and will warrant and forever defend by these presents

at Greenville on the 9th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty four in the 78th year of the Independence of the
United States of America
