dred Dollars to me in hand paid by C. B. Garrison of the State and District
aforesaid have Granted Bargained and sold and released and by
these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and release unto the said C. B. Garrison
all that tract of land (excepting the grain yard containing one fourth of
an acre in a square from equal distance on all sides from the fence)
together with the right of way to and from said grain yard) it being the
place where I now live and lying on the South side of the Road leading from
Spartintown to C. H. to Wilson's Bridge on Sandy Creek and on the way
of Shady Dr. Containing Two Hundred acres more or less.
