Where all know by these presents that whereas my wife Jane T Burns is entitled to

estate real and personal arising from the estate of the said deceased, the late Thomas Allen consisting of money in the hands of the Guardian & Executor and funds in the hands of the Commissioners in Equity of Greenville District amounting together to the sum of Two Thousand and one hundred and six dollars and whereas my said wife is entitled to an estate amounting in a house and lot of land situated in the Town of Greenville on Washington Street & Main Street adjoining the lot of Emanuel Johnson whereon her mother now resides and whereas I have not claimed or received or reduced into my possession any part or portion of said property since my marriage with my said wife and being desirous to secure to her the benefit of the same by July first from my own credit or contracts and in consideration of the love and affection which I have and bear to my said wife as well as in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid by William Henry Allen the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged I William H Burns of the said town and State aforesaid have signed, granted, relinquished and conveyed to the said William Henry Allen all and singular the money and funds of the estate of my said wife Jane T Burns in the hands of the said Guardian and the Commissioners in Equity of Greenville District as herein before mentioned and all my right, title and interest and claim in and to the same and also all of the interest in the estate and share and to the lot of land herein before mentioned described situate and lying in the Town of Greenville of the said deceased and all my right title and interest in and to the same to the said William Henry Allen In Trust notwithstanding it is agreed that the said William Henry Allen shall keep together the principal and interest of the whole estate and pay over annually the interest or proceeds of the same at least to my said wife Jane T Burns on her separate receipt and for her sole and separate use, free from all debts, contracts, engagements or entanglements of myself or any future husband during her life and after her death the said Trustee shall hold the said property and estate herein before specified in trust to and for the use and benefit of the lawful issue of my said wife living at her death to be equally divided between them the children in children of a deceased child to represent the parents interest but shall be the due without leaving lawful issue alive than the property to go to the heirs living according to the Statute of Distributions of this State And the said Henry Allen and his successors shall have power to invest any portion of said estate in personal or real property and to apply the proceeds as herein before stated and to sell and remit of in the opinion and sound discretion of said Trustee such investment shall be advantageous to the said trust.
