Know all men by these presents that I Olive Parrott of the District and State aforesaid for the sum of Fifty dollars to me paid by J. H. Cleveland have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said J. H. Cleveland all that parcel of Land on the West Coast of North Saluda River ditch containing by estimation four acres be the same more or less the same being all the Land which I possess on the West side of said River ditch it being part of the Tract of Land known as the "W. - an all place

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining

To Have and to hold to all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said J. H. Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby by these presents my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend unto the said J. H. Cleveland his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof

Witness my hand and seal this 10th day of February 1854 and in the second eighth year of the Independence of America
