bargain sell and release convey and convey to the said Harris Pit
man All that plantation, tract or parcel of land containing One Hundred
acres or the same or less situate lying and being in the State District
aforesaid on the high waters of Santee's Fork of Sedge River beginning
in a Chestnut thence S 78° W 23.50 to a Dogwood thence S 100° W 10 to
W 2 & 20 thence W 21° W 33.00 to a chestnut thence N 57° W 20.00 to a
Sycamore thence to a chestnut oak thence to a White Oak thence
to a Hickory thence S 4° E to a Stake thence S 66° E 23.00 to a pine
thence a straight line from the Pine to the beginning it being a part of a
tract of land granted to Benjamin Sartin

Together with all and singular the rights members her
-editments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the
premises herebefore mentioned unto the said Harris Pitman his heirs
and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defende all and singular
the said premises unto the said Harris Pitman his heirs and assigns ag
-ainst myself my heirs and assigns & every other person excepted so long
-as ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
