all of which property I have this day bargained Sold and thereby
release relinquish unto the said Brockman this Thirs and ays in the
Adm^t the Signor Sealed day and date below written

The conditions of the above Bill of sale or mortgage
and Transfer is as follows that whereas the said Arch^d Vaughan stands
indebted to Col^r Strode in the sum of Some Thirty eight Dollars and
to Thomas P. Brockman and The P. Brockman son also for
One Hundred and Six dollars and Thirty cents to this date and whereas
the said The P. Brockman & Son and several other Gentleman are on the
said Vaughan note to Strode as the object of this Bill of conveyance
first to secure the payment of said note and secondly to secure the said
Brockman in their debt Now know ye that of the said Vaughan
shall well and truly pay off the above debts on or before the 1st day
of November next then the above Bill of sale or conveyance will
be null and void otherwise the said The P. Brockman may pur-
sue further to take into his possession all the aforesaid property
and he sell the same by due notice say ten days by cash or at a
credit as may seem most advisable to him the said Brockman
and he forth to pay the note to Col^r Strode and interest there to apply the
residue to the payment of the debt due the said The P. Brockman & The
P. Brockman & Son and see only to the amount of all the aforesaid debts
and it is moreover a part of this Transfer Sale that the said Brockman
is hereby authorized to enter the premises at any time before the 1st day
of November next and seize and carry off any part or all the property
above specified if in his opinion it is likely to be removed or otherwise dis-
troyed and shall not be held liable for a trespass which without this distinct un-
derstanding might be regarded in law as a trespass any law or usage to
