


acres, one rood and two perches more or less, being at the head of Main Street and on which a dwelling house stands, and other improvements are located, beginning at a stake near the dwelling house upon the East side of Main Street and running thence with said line, 318 E 2 chains and 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ links to judge All, thence with judge All, 1732 E 2 chains and 86 links to C Elford's lot, thence with said lot 166 2 chains and 84 links to a stake thence S 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 70 links to Brown street thence with Brown street 188 34 links to a stake, thence still with Brown street N 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 5 chains and 82 links to a start of fifty feet with thence with said street 162 00 four chains and 86 links to the road which extends NE from Main Street being the Old Spartanburg Road, thence with said road 525 00 5 chains and 75 links to a stake, and thence round a curved line with the same 74 links to the beginning corner in the said four lots of land being a portion of the tract of Land conveyed to me by F. M. Hall by deed bearing date May the 12th 1852 together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and I do hereby fully and perfectly dedicate and release to the public use forever all the streets which have been opened by me upon the said tract of land purchased from MacLoyd. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said C Elford his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said C Elford his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.


