 Land it part of a tract of Land granted to Wm Barton lying on the
 head waters of Saluda River, containing one hundred acres more
 or less, beginning at the river, running thence N 70 W to a stake
 thence N 10 E 31 chains to a stake thence down the Branch to a
 black Gum distance not known, thence S 2 W to a Poplar, thence
 S 61 E 21 chains to a Pine, thence a straight line to the beginning on
 the river, the same being one hundred acres more or less which I do
 bargain sell & release to the said Wilson Barton his heirs and assigns
 forever and I do well bind myself, my heirs Administrators, Executors
 and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
 unto the said Wilson Barton his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs
 & assigns or any other person or persons from claiming the same or any part
