 sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and re-
 lease unto the said James D. Sherman as that piece parcel and Part of Land
 containing one hundred & thirty one acres more or less, situate lying being
 in the District and State aforesaid on both sides of the Spartanburg road
 about four miles distant from Greenville Court House having
 the following lines, boundaries and buttings, viz, beginning at a Pine
 stump on the Spartanburg road Parry McDev's corner and running thence
 N 29° E 10 to a rock O. J. S. A. M. thence N 85° E 17.11 to a Gum corner, thence
 N 85° E 16.40 to a Pine S. S. thence S 23° E 4.92 to a Stake S. on Spartanburg road
 thence with said road S 89° W 8.80 to a Stake S., thence still with said road
 S 82° 10 W 16.25 to a Stake opposite Cherry, thence across said road S 71° W 1.25
 to a small Black Oak S., thence S 84° W 4.3. 80 to a Stake S., thence S 110° W 4.10
 to a Rock S., 6 M. thence N 80° W 14.11 to a Red Oak S. (gone), thence
