Deed The State of North Carolina
For Heron all men by these presents that I
For Washington C. Archer of Greenville
District in the State of aforesaid

in consideration of Fifty five hundred dollars to me
paid by John W Walker of Greenville District in the
State of aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said John W Walker all that Lot of Land
situate, lying & being in the Town of Greenville and State
of aforesaid, on which the Levy Stable is located, being
laid down as Lots 18 in the North East part of Paulsons
plan of the said Town and having the following boundaries
and dimensions, viz, being two hundred feet on Wash-
ington Street on the South, one hundred & twenty feet on
Spring Street on the East, Two hundred feet with M D Lee Lot
on the North, and one hundred & twenty feet on Brown St
on the West, being the same lot conveyed to me by Samuel
McAuldin by Deed bearing date August 29th 1858.

Together with all and singular the rights, liberties,
franchises, and appurtenances therunto belonging or
in anywise incident or appertaining I have and do
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto
the said John W Walker, his heirs and assigns forever.
And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and admin-
istrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said John Walker, his heirs
